

Memon Industrial & Technical Institute (MITI)

In the quest of serving humanity without any discrimination of caste, creed or religion, the WMO embarked on a vocational training project in the middle of 2007 with the resolve of setting up a high profile training facility as a not-for-profit program. The sole objective was to help youth of the less privileged class in acquiring vocational skills which could lead to economic mobility for them in a short period of time.

This would also aid in developing human-capital for the Country geared up to meet the demand of quality skilled and semi-skilled manpower. The project has been named “Memon Industrial & Technical Institute (MITI)” and is situated in one of the largest industrial zones of Pakistan - the Korangi Industrial Estate, Karachi.

The idea surfaced in April 2007 when the Haji Abdul Razzak Yaqoob and other delegates of WMO, who were present in Karachi to attend the 5th Annual General Assembly Meeting of WMO, got in contact with the City Nazim, Mr. Mustafa Kamal, and conveyed the desire of WMO to establish a vocational training institute in city on the lines of Ebrahim Bawany Industrial Training Institute that was running successfully under the auspices of Islamic Study Centre at Baroda, India.

The City Nazim was inspired by the idea and promised to do something in this regard. He invited Mr. Haji Abdul Razzak Yaqoob (ARY), Mr. Pir Muhammad Kaliya, Mr. Shoaib Ismail Mangroria, Mr. H.M. Shahzad and Mr. Abdul Rashid Godil to his office to discuss further and pin down the modalities. He, after listening to the views of Haji Sahib and other members of the delegation, decided to provide the site either in the form of land or a constructed building.

A three-member committee of WMO was formed, which consisted of Mr. Shoaib Ismail Mangroria, Mr. H. M. Shahzad and Mr. Abdul Rashid Godil, to visit various sites offered by the City Government. The committee judiciously decided upon accepting the Korangi Civic Centre-III, a four level building with constructed space of 136,000 square feet over 6.20 acres of land, situated on Plot No.ST-1/8, Sector 36-A, Korangi 5 1/2, Karachi.

After having a series of meetings, the final Memorandum of Understanding between the CDGK and the World Memon Organization was signed on 8th

March, 2008. The possession of the plot of land along with the building thereon was handed over to WMO on 13th March, 2008.

The mammoth site provides plenty of room for conducting a number of courses and covers a large population in the adjoining localities where such a facility could easily find thousands of students. The pertinent object of the Technical Institute signifies that it will be ensured that there should be no discrimination of caste, creed or religion in the admission of students in the Institute. The Admissions shall strictly be on merit.

A Committee consisting of Mr. H.M. Shahzad, Mr. Pir Muhammad Kaliya, Mr. Shoab Ismail Mangroria, Mr. Abdul Rashid Godil was constituted for the project. The committee held meetings regularly to review the progress. The Chairman of the committee, Mr. H.M. Shahzad had personally assumed the responsibility of getting the job done with regards to all kind of repairs, construction and modifications work required to make the building ready for running a vocational institute – thanks to his energetic and persistent efforts, the building, which was taken over by WMO in a worn-out state, now emerged on the landscape as an eye-catching structure within the Korangi Industrial Area.

The rationale behind the initiative was letting a demoralized and deprived person explore his potential to earn reasonably well with dignity and his mental peace can stop the growing deterioration in our society. This is the best charity one can do for the community or nation in entirety.

The Memon Industrial & Technical Institute (MITI) has now become a reality and a pride of Pakistan. In reaching at this stage of glory we are extremely thankful to all those who have contributed in this great cause.

MITI has completed five years of successful service to humanity on 31st May 2014. A lot of milestones have been achieved in the last five years. It may be noted that currently over 50 different courses are being offered at MITI for both men and women. So far, over 50,000 students have been trained at MITI. Numerous delegations from abroad and Pakistan have visited MITI and have been impressed by the state-of-the-art facilities and ideal infrastructure. International institutions have also commended the quality of technical courses.

We, at MEMON ALAM, wish MITI the very best in all its future endeavors.

Five Years of Excellence 2009- 2014

An article about Memon Industrial and Technical Institute has to begin with the man who had a dream to impact the countless less fortunate youth who could not complete their education. This man was none other than Haji Abdul Razzak Yaqoob Gandhi (ARY), Founder President of the World Memon Organization (WMO) who is well known as a business man who could hold his own among the biggest business persons in the world. His other passion was the welfare of the Memon community in particular but Pakistanis in general. He firmly believed that education was the key to prosperity and supported all educational projects generously. But the project closest to his heart was the Memon Industrial and Technical Institute (MITI) which was his brainchild and dream. This project was created to impart technical and vocational training to rehabilitate the less fortunate youth who could not complete even their high school education and were fated to become street children with all the risk factors involved especially

leading to violence and extremism. Even when confined to a hospital bed in his last days, he kept enquiring about the progress of MITI.

As fate would have it, the City Nazim at the time, Mr. Mustafa Kamal decided to join hands in this venture and provided the premises for the project. The initial funding for the project was provided by Haji Abdul Razzak himself and subsequently by the World Memon Organization and philanthropic persons of the Memon community worldwide. The responsibility for the implementation of the project was given to one of his most trusted lieutenants, Mr. H.M. Shahzad, and as they say the rest is history.

MITI came into existence as a project of WMO-PC in 2009 at the premises provided by CDGK. It is now 5 years since MITI opened its gates to 254 students in JUNE 2009 in 7 courses for boys only; and since then the management has remained focused towards achieving the goals charted by the founding fathers of World

Memon Organization and MITI. These inter alia included providing affordable and quality vocational education to the youth of low income group and continuous improvement in quality and services of the Institute while strictly adhering to the WMO principles of charity, welfare and service to humanity. Although Haji Sahib envisioned MITI as providing training free of cost, he later compromised on a nominal fee. As such, MITI has a highly subsidized fee structure but for deserving students it is still free. In the early years, financial viability of MITI remains linked to the philanthropic assistance of WMO and other business organizations that JUNE be referred to as our partners. However, the management strived to increase admissions and explored other areas of income generation for coming close to achieving financial stability and independence.

MITI has been progressing steadily in providing good quality vocational training to boys and ladies. Initially, our



focus areas were Landhi, Korangi, Shah Faisal Colony and Malir. This has now expanded to other towns such as Lyari and Sultanabad.

Government and international training organizations, impressed by our facilities enlisted MITI as their training partners. Consequently MITI is now service provider for Benazir Bhutto Youth Development Scheme, Karachi Youth

Initiative and Prime Minister's Youth Development Scheme. As a result, MITI has been able to come close to achieving self-sustenance and financial independence without sacrificing the ideals for which MITI was built. And by the Grace of Allah SWT, we are successfully progressing in that direction by strict financial discipline and increasing admissions.

MITI has two major goals: Continuous

development and increasing admissions. Several initiatives in this regard are summarized below. The success of these efforts is visible in the steady increase in admissions over the years to 2100 and 4000 in the Boys' and Ladies sections respectively by end JUNE 2014. As another milestone in its operation, more than 55,398 boys and ladies have benefitted from the facilities of MITI since its inception.

- a) New Courses were added in the Curriculum in both Boys and Ladies Sections.
- b) Existing Facilities were improved and Capacity was increased.
- c) Promotional Activities were undertaken to increase awareness about MITI.
- d) Registration with City & Guilds and Trade Testing Board was completed.

- f) MITI website was launched.
- g) Relationships with partners were strengthened.
- h) Contracted agreement with Benazir Bhutto Shaheed Youth Development Program.
- i) Contracted agreement with Karachi Youth Initiative.
- j) Memon Institute of Hijama Therapy was inaugurated.
- k) Contract agreement with NAVTTC
- l) Contract agreement with Intel

A number of new courses were introduced with special emphasis on I.T. As such a completely new well equipped I.T. section was constructed with all facilities including audio visual equipment under well qualified teachers. In the future this is destined to become the Flag Ship of MITI Insha Allah.

The Memon Institute of Hijama Therapy (MIHT) started operations on 2nd February, 2012. MIHT has been built in the premises of Memon Industrial and Technical Institute (MITI) under management of Chairman MITI, Mr. H.M. Shahzad and COO, Mr. Shahab Hasan. Dr. Asif Ahmed is the Medical Director. The inauguration of the

building had been carried out on 8th April, 2011 on the occasion of the visit of Mr. Abdul Sattar Dada, President WMO and other international dignitaries by Haji Jan Mohammad Yaqoob Gandhi.



In the MIHT, treatment is done on the basis of Hijama based on the Sunnah of the Holy Prophet, Sallallahu alaihi e wasalam. The building measures 43' x 30'.

It includes 3 rooms for doctors, a meeting room, changing room and 5 patient beds. All the equipment required for a modern clinic is available at MIHT. MIHT has been built to give treatment to all sections of society at a very nominal cost because it is intended to be run on a not-for-profit basis. Many of the patients who are unable to bear even this nominal cost are provided treatment without payment of any fees. In the first phase, the facility will be used for treatment only and in the second phase very shortly the training and research function will also be started. From its beginning the MIHT has treated more than 37,176 patients. Among them are many patients who come from many foreign countries for treatment.





The Future

MITI prides itself in becoming a premier institution for vocational training in the country and the management and staff of MITI are committed in its continued growth to help the destitute people of society

for upward mobility.

We are humbled by the achievements and are grateful to Allah SWT for guiding us in the right direction and giving success in our ventures.

But the progress of MITI lies in continuous improvement and development. As such a road map of future strategy has been made as given below:

Expansion and Renovation of Facilities

By the grace of Allah, MITI has completed 5 years of operation. In these 5 years, we have served almost 50,000 students. These students have been well received by the industry locally as well as internationally which is due to hard work and commitment of the management and our faculty team. To achieve these objectives, our workshops and other facilities were built with limited investment to satisfy the training needs of the time.

In the last 5 years many other similar institutes have come up in the city who have taken inspiration from our experience. Some of them are smaller clones but some of them are in a similar class as ours and although we would not like to admit it, they are competing with us in real terms.

During these 5 years, MITI has focused on increasing admissions and have been successful to a large extent. However, we have not been able to do much in the area of further development of our facilities and curricula. Although MITI is now able to meet its operational expenses by its own means, it cannot finance the development expenses. Management specialists know that either you progress and grow or you die. There is no status quo. The time has now come when we are faced with the reality of the following:

1. Attrition of equipment:

Many of the equipment and facilities have become old while new ones have not been

added. The present facilities are falling behind the requirements and advancements in industry.

For example, the time of the carburetor engine has passed. Nowadays no car is without EFI. Same is the case with automatic transmission, etc.

Electrical control panels in industry are now all involving advanced electronics. We need to upgrade these and other courses to keep alive the interests of the students and stay ahead of the competition or at least in step.

Computer hardware is another big area which requires upgradation. Our computers are no longer compatible with the software that are now available and have become standards of the industry and which we are teaching. So far, we have been coping with these requirements by local upgradations but this has a limit. This includes all the computers in our classes as well as the servers in the I.T. room.

2. New Courses

To remain competitive, it is necessary to keep pace with the needs of the students and employers and introduce new courses from time to time. We have not introduced any new course in the last 2 years. We badly need to begin the following courses which are demands of the industry:

- Machining & Bench Fitting
- Industrial Electronics
- Instrumentation
- Fashion Marketing & Merchandizing
- Auto body Refinishing
- Alternate Energy
- Diploma of Associate Engineer in Mechanical
- Electrical
- Computer Science
- Automobile
- Refrigeration & Air Conditioning

3. Facilities Maintenance/ Refurbishment:

Besides the academic needs, there are needs of building and facilities.

The most important in this category is the stand-by generator which has now almost become our main source of electricity and is our lifeline. The present generator has become under capacity due to increase in requirement as well as becoming old.

The fiber glass roof is leaking badly and needs to be replaced. We also need a fully functional and well equipped Auditorium.

All these requirements are estimated to cost about USD 300,000. Your valuable contribution in this cause is the dire need of MITI which can rightly be called the flagship project of the World Memon Organization.



Onwards, he visited the Hijama Department and got inspired by the Hijama therapy in such professional way.





Orientation Ceremony of the 14th Batch of the Boys & 12th Batch of the Ladies' Sections




First day at school is always a day of joy and excitement with feelings of hope and expectation for all students. It is a day to make new friends and take a step ahead in their lives towards a bright future.
